## Dave Borchardt Famous Bread Pudding

### Ingredients

3 - 3 ½ Bolillo Rolls Fresh  
2 TBS Butter, Melted  
¾ cup Raisins  
4 Eggs, Beaten  
2 cups Whole Milk  
¾ cup White Granulated Sugar  
1 TSP Ground Cinnamon  
1 TSP Vanilla Extract

### SAUCE

1 cup Whole Milk  
2 TBS Butter  
1/3 cup White Granulated Sugar  
1 TSP Vanilla  
1 TBS Flour  
Dash Salt

### Directions

Preheat oven to 350  
Cut bread into small pieces and put in 9x9 pan  
drizzle melted butter over bread add raisins.  
In medium bowl, mix beaten eggs, milk, sugar  
cinnamon and vanilla (mix well)  
Pour over bread, push bread down slightly with  
fork so all liquid is soaked up  
Bake for 45 minutes or until the top springs  
back when lightly tapped

### Directions

Mix everything together and bring to a boil for  
3-4 minutes stirring constantly, then set aside  
for 5 minutes and then pour over warm bread  
pudding

## RESTAURANT REVIEW

On Tuesday, September 17, 21 ladies from our park met for lunch at Crackers & Co. on Greenfield & Brown. Crackers serves a variety of delicious, classic favorites for breakfast, including pancakes, eggs, Belgian waffles, French toast, biscuits, crepes, “blintzes” alongside an assortment of meats, gravies, granola, yogurts, chocolates, creams, fruit toppings. Lunch was a medley of soups, salads, sandwiches, & burgers, again with an array of sides such as: chili, sweet potato, French fries; fruit cups & bowls; cottage cheese; garlic bread. Sandwiches were crafted on a choice of breads-croissant, pita, country white, wheat, etc. Wait staff was adequate for our group. My personal order of Southwest eggs Benedict was recommended by the server when I asked what was good. Tasty, however, lukewarm even tho I was served first. Most everyone was happy with their meals, but again, a few dishes were lukewarm. I’d give Crackers a 3.5 out of 5. I would definitely try this place with ONE guest to see if my food was hotter!
