On Tuesday, September 17, 21 ladies from our park met for lunch at Crackers & Co. on Greenfield & Brown. Crackers serves a variety of delicious, classic favorites for breakfast, including pancakes, eggs, Belgian wafles, French toast, biscuits, crepes, "blintzes" alongside an assortment of meats, gravies, granola, yogurts, chocolates, creams, fruit toppings. Lunch was a medley of soups, salads, sandwiches, & burgers, again with an aray of sides such as: chili, sweet potato, French fries; fruit cups & bowls; cottage cheese; garlic bread. Sandwiches were crafted on a choice of breads-croissant, pita, country white, wheat, etc. Wait staff was adequate for our group. My personal order of Southwest eggs Benedict was recommended by the server when I asked what was good. Tasty, however, lukewarm even tho I was served first. Most everyone was happy with their meals, but again, a few dishes were lukewarm. I'd give Crackers a 3.5 out of 5. I would definitely try this place with ONE guest to see if my food was hotter! 
